In the year 19-20, lot of changes were made on the academic front where we added many subject enrichment, Student Portfolio, and hands on learning activities to the curriculum. The assessment pattern too underwent modifications based on latest circulars from CBSE.

The year started with a summer camp and a movie trip to watch Dumbo. We were happy to welcome our new students who joined the ICS family in April. To improve upon and inspire an individual is great, but greater still is inspiring a group, and with this in our mind, a Parent Orientation Program and A phonic Workshop was organized for parents to help their child develop good academic and reading skills and update them about our school culture.

As true learning is much more than imparting 3 R's of Reading, Writing and Arithmetic, the school calendar remained studded with a rich variety of co-curricular activities in house or extramural amongst which Show and tell, Story Telling Competition, File Making, Drawing Competition, Debates, Fancy Dress, Recitation Competition are there to name a few.

As said by Martin Rees, "Crucial to science, education is hands in involvement: showing, not just telling; real experiments and field trips and not just Virtual Reality." An activity on the Three R's of Waste Management, Reduce, Reuse and Recycle was conducted to support the Swach Bharat Abhiyaan where our students took a pledge for not using plastic and saving the environment.

Various clubs activities were introduced this year for skill development and to bring out creativity under Reading Club, Integrity Club, Eco Club, Heritage Club, etc. For Resource person Interaction, A pottery session of diya making and Fire Safety session was conducted for life skills development. Many saplings were planted in the campus by our students to make the school environs greener and healthier.

Competitive exams are one way to give the students an exposure and help to extend their boundaries. Many participated in Inter and Intra SCHOOL COMPETITIONS for Skating and Karate Championship and won prizes and brought laurels to the school. Few would be going ahead for State and National Level Championships to represent our school. 40 of our students took karate belt exam and qualified for yellow belt.

Assemblies are an essential part of schools, for they not only promote a sense of collective belonging to the school but they also educate the students in various ways

Variety is the spice of life. Formative and Summative Exams probably do not facilitate an aptitude in certain disciplines. To compensate the lacuna the school organised a plethora of like National Science, International Maths and International English Olympiads. This year we also were also approached by Humming Bird for National Spell Bee competition.

Much is said and done about passing on our rich cultural heritage to the coming generations but I believe that the school is the place where the real handling taking takes place. Curriculum for this year was marked with various celebrations, National and cultural festivals, competitions, special days spread over the year to make the children understand their importance in our lives.

The school has never failed to find method in the madness of innovative learning.
